SUNDAY SCHOOL SCOOP!

Today the children will be learning what it means to place complete confidence in God. We will be reading about Jonathan and His Armor Bearer. Our bible verses are "It may be that the Lord will work for us, for nothing can hinder the Lord from saving by many or by few" (1 Samuel 14:6b). Jonathan believed in the promise and power of God - the promise that God would deliver the Philistines into the hands of Israel, and the power to overcome the odds against them. He knew God's ability was not dependent on numbers and military might. It didn't matter that there were only two of them. You are only one, but God is everything. The second bible verse: "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31). God has guaranteed victory over sin and death through Jesus. Trusting in sure victory means placing confidence in His work, not our own, for deliverance; and it means believing that there is nothing, and there is no one, strong enough to prevent His promise from happening.
