The Love Feast

The Love Feast is a simple, ritual meal that is shared along with hymns, Scripture, and stories of faith. The founder of Methodism, John Wesley, instituted the Love Feast, or Agape Meal as it is sometimes called, and was often shared in small settings with covenant and discipleship groups.

Theologically, the Love Feast derives from Jewish and early church meals such as are referred to by the Apostle Paul. It is a Christian fellowship meal recalling the meals Jesus shared with disciples during his ministry and expressing the community, sharing, and fellowship enjoyed by the family of Christ. Although its origins in the early church are closely interconnected with the origins of Holy Communion, the two services became quite distinct and should not be confused with each other. Today we share in a Love Feast as there is not an ordained Elder present to administer the sacrament of Holy Communion. So as not to confuse the Love Feast with Holy Communion, we will share crackers and grapes in place of the bread and cup.

You are invited to come forward during the communion music, as you would during Holy Communion, to partake of the Love Feast. Come down the center aisle to the table at the rail, take a cracker and grapes and return to your seats by the side aisles.
