Commission on a Way Forward

At the 2016 General Conference, a 32-member Commission was appointed by the Council of Bishops to examine paragraphs in The Book of Discipline concerning human sexuality and exploring options to strengthen the unity of the church. This Commission on a Way Forward - has submitted its report to the Council of Bishops, offering three possible plans to guide a way forward. The Council of Bishops is recommending one of those plans, called the One Church Plan, the only one that addresses the issue without schism or major restructuring of the global Church. The Council of Bishops has called a Special Session of the General Conference of The United Methodist Church to be held February 23-26, 2019, in St. Louis, Missouri to act on a plan.

You are invited to attend an informal information session to learn more about the Commission, the three plans, and what this could mean for the denomination in general and churches like ours in particular.
